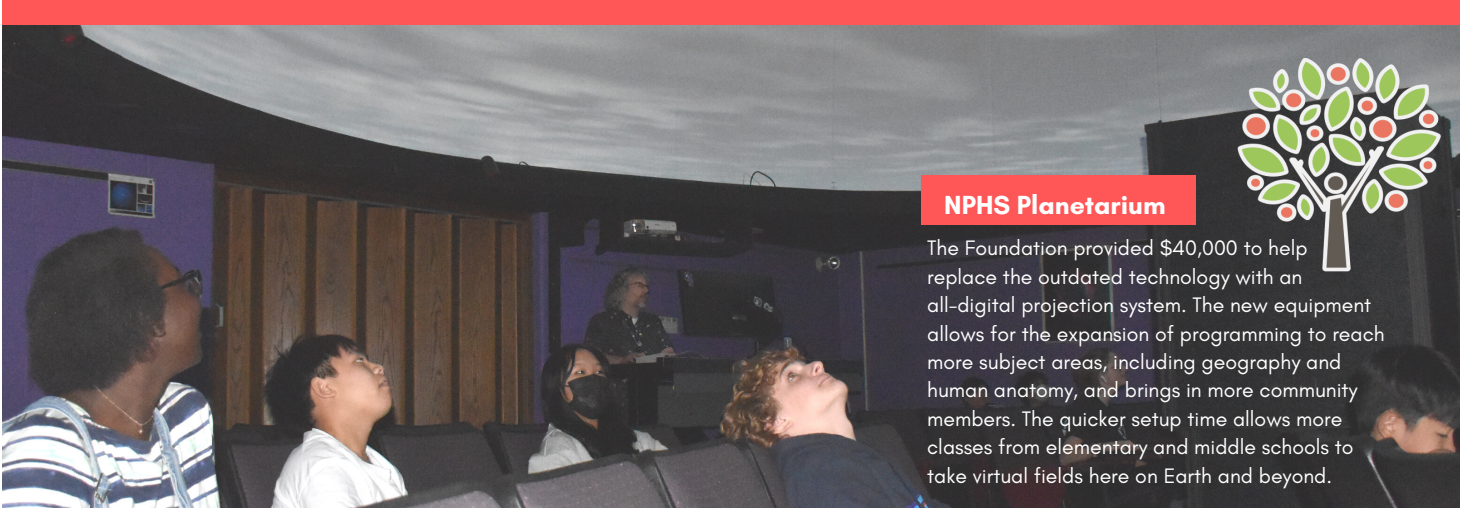




EXPAND STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES
